How to Cite Sources in APA Citation Format - Mendeley

For a two-part title, capitalize the first word of the second part of the title. Also capitalize proper nouns. Do not italicize. End with a period. Capitalize all major words in the periodical name. Follow with a comma. Italicize the periodical name (but not the comma after). Italicize the volume number.

APA style dictates that brackets should directly surround their content without spaces (e.g., [bracketed content] should look like this). When possible, include the year, month, and date in references. If the month and date are not available, use the year of publication.

APA has a few formatting guidelines for the reference list. The reference list should start on a separate page at the end of your paper. Use one-inch margins and continue the header from the rest of your paper. Title the page References, centered at the top (no bold, italics, quotation marks, etc.).

References: Format & Examples - APA Citation & Style Guide ...

The APA reference page is a separate page at the end of your paper where all sources you cited in the main text are listed. The references are sorted alphabetically, double spaced, and formatted using a hanging indent of ½ inch. Use "References" as page heading and include a running head with your paper title and page number.

APA Citation Style Guide - Library Research Guides

Citation styles differ in the naming of this list: in APA it is the reference page, in MLA it is the works cited, and in Chicago A it is the bibliography. There are also differences in the order of information and how you format each entry. The format often depends on the type of source (e.g. book, website, or journal article).
