Part A, or hospital insurance premium, is free for eligible beneficiaries, those who have paid taxes to Medicare while working. Medicare Part B is not free at all, as it charges a premium based on your income. ### **Medicare and Medicaid Basics - CMS**

- Original Medicare includes Medicare Part A (Hospital Insurance) and Part B (Medical Insurance).
- If you want drug coverage, you can join a separate Medicare drug plan (Part D).
- To help pay your out-of-pocket costs in Original Medicare (like your 20% coinsurance), you can also shop for and buy supplemental coverage.

Medicare Part A (Hospital Insurance) Part A covers inpatient hospital stays, care in a skilled nursing facility, hospice care, and some home health care. Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance) Part B covers certain doctors' services, outpatient care, medical supplies, and preventive services. Medicare Part D (prescription drug coverage)

You may have to sign up if you're 65 (or almost 65) and not getting Social Security. There are certain times of the year when you can sign up or change how you get your coverage. If you sign up for Medicare Part B when you're first eligible, you can avoid a penalty. You can choose how you get your Medicare coverage.

### **Get started with Medicare | Medicare**

Get the basics. When you first enroll in Medicare and during certain times of the year, you can choose how you get your Medicare coverage. There are 2 main ways to get your Medicare coverage— Original Medicare (Part A and Part B) or a Medicare Advantage Plan (Part C). Some people need to get additional coverage, like Medicare drug coverage or Medicare Supplement Insurance (Medigap).

### **Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) | SSA**

Medicare Part D is insurance for outpatient prescription drugs — meaning medications you take yourself instead of having them administered in a hospital or doctor's office. Medicare's drug benefit was added to the program only in 2006, a full 40 years after Medicare began. Since then, it has saved huge amounts of money for millions of people and allowed many to get the meds they need for the first time.
