NON- NUMERICAL SCORING SYSTEMS REQUIRE EXPLANATION If the RFP uses a non-numerical rating system, for the sake of fairness to the competitors, it is necessary for you to explain in writing how you came to rank the individual offers the way you did. The evaluation must be rational and consistently applied from competitor to competitor.

18 Evaluation Scoring Guidelines Scores will be adjusted to reflect the weight assigned to each criterion. Each criterion must be reviewed according to the requested items of the RFP and scored based on the scoring definitions above. Only the Criteria in the Evaluation Form will receive scores.

SCORES: A score will be calculated for each Proposal based on the average of scores from RFP advisory review panel members. Proposals will be considered within each funding source and ranked by score with a priority to first fund the highest scored. Remaining Proposals may be considered for awards dependent on available funding.
